The request dated 08.02.2023 of Ministry of Defence for exemption from 2% random screening for the foreign delegates attending Aero India-2023 scheduled to be held from 13th to 17th February, 2023 has been considered in consultation with Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. Based on the No Objection given by the M/o H&FW, Ministry of Civil Aviation has decided to grant exemption to arriving foreign delegates at Indian Airports - Delhi, Mumbai and Bengaluru Airports for attending Aero India-2023 at Yelahanka, Bengaluru from 2% random testing for COVID-19.
