

State-wise Quarantine Guidelines

Chhattisgarh



Domestic

Institutional quarantine: Not applicable

Home quarantine: Passengers will be advised to remain in home isolation for 7 days.

Health screening

- Thermal screening will be conducted for all passengers
- All passengers traveling to Chhattisgarh will be asked to show a negative report of RT-PCR done within 96 hours of arrival at the Airport

Covid test

- All arriving passengers need to show their RT-PCR test done within 96 hours of arrival at the airport or certificate of both doses of COVID vaccine
- Passengers with RT-PCR test report not within 96 hours of arrival will have to undergo COVID test on arrival

Passenger obligation

- All arriving passengers need to show their RT-PCR test done within 96 hours of arrival at the airport or certificate of both doses of COVID vaccine
- Passengers with RT-PCR test report not within 96 hours of arrival will have to undergo COVID test on arrival
- Passengers (whose test is conducted at the airport) will have to be in home isolation until their RT-PCR report is received

Airline obligation

- Airlines to guide all arrival passengers to the health screening area for thermal screening and for checking if passengers are in possession of a negative RT-PCR report
- Airlines need to inform the passengers about the latest guidelines issued by the state government

Airport or State obligation

- Thermal screening will be conducted for all passengers.
- All arriving passengers will be asked to show either a negative report of RT-PCR done within 96 hours of arrival at the Airport or COVID vaccination certificate (both doses). If any passenger does not possess the RT-PCR report done within 96 hours he/she will have to undergo COVID test on arrival at the airport. He/she will have to in home isolation until the report is received.
