Quarantine Regulations

Health Check Requirements: Effective 04th July 2021, it is mandatory to possess a negative RT-PCR certificate not older than 72 hours for all passengers originating from Kerala. Negative RT-PCR certificate not older than 72 hours or vaccination certificate of at least one dose of COVID 19 vaccine shall be compulsorily produced by the passengers from Maharashtra. For travelers from all other states, it is mandatory that those with COVID -19 symptoms should carry a RTPCR Negative Test Report.

Quarantine Requirements:

Exemptions (if any): Permitted exemptions for negative RT-PCR certificate for travellers from Maharashtra are as follows: a) Vaccination certificate of having received at least one dose of COVID 19 vaccine. b) Constitutional functionaries and health care professionals. c) Children below 2 years. d) In dire emergency situation (death in family, medical treatment etc)

Additional Information (if any) : The cost of RT -PCR test at Bengaluru airport is INR 800/- PER PERSON.
