Quarantine Regulations

Health Check Requirements : It is mandatory for passengers to carry negative RT-PCR report not earlier than 72 hours before the time of entry into Maharashtra. Passengers without RT-PCR report will not be permitted to board the flight. RT-PCR timeline starts from the report issuance time. The conditions for exemptions to travel without RT-PCR report are as follows: 1. Passengers must have been administered with both doses of the COVID 19 vaccination. 2. 15 days should have elapsed after the second dose. 3. Passengers must be in possession of a valid Final vaccination certificate displayed on the Aarogya Setu app issued through the COWIN portal.

Quarantine Requirements : All passengers who intend to stay in Maharashtra for a period of 7 days or less shall be exempted from mandatory quarantine. Such passengers will have to share the details of their return/onward journey. Other passengers will have to undergo home quarantine for 14 days. To seek exemption from home quarantine, it is mandatory to upload the request online at <https://portal.mcgm.gov.in> before your travel.

Exemptions (if any) : Quarantine Requirements : The armed forces personnel and their families from the Army, Navy, Air force and the Coast Guard are exempted from the above-mentioned RT-PCR tests subject to following the other necessary Covid related protocols.

Additional Information (if any) : All passengers travelling from airports located within Maharashtra are exempted from RT-PCR Test/Certificate requirements. As per Ministry of Civil Aviation guidelines, the exemptions to travel without RT-PCR report for fully vaccinated passengers DO NOT APPLY to international travelers arriving into Maharashtra.
